Mrs. Amy Lee Maultsby Colvett, a lifetime resident of Pulaski, Tenn., died peacefully at her home surrounded by her family on Friday, April 9th.

She was born on September 20, 1947, to parents Cora Lee Jones and Morris Rogers Maultsby. She was a retired and fifth-generation employee of the Postal Service, a loyal member of East Hill Church of Christ, and a published photographer. 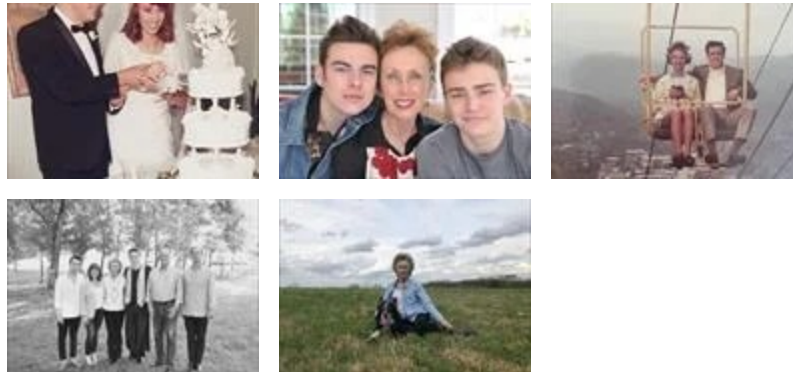
