He retired from the Tennessee State Government after 20 years of employment. and served as magistrate for Giles County and was a substitute

teacher for Giles County School. Jerome accepted Christ at an early age at First Baptist Church in Columbia, Tennessee.

Jerome was a faithful member of the Trinity Family Church in Columbia, Tennessee. He had a strong faith and demonstrated his faith in so many ways. He was very active in our community. 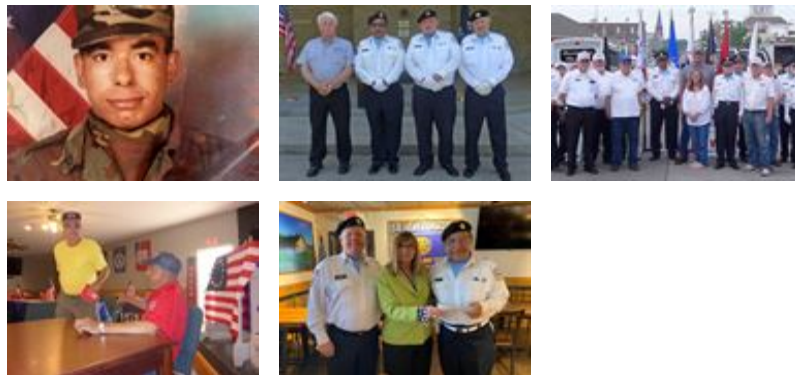
