



## Bennita Branch Rouleau

Bennita Rouleau of Pulaski, Tennessee passed away Sunday morning, January 28th, 2024, at NHC Pulaski. She was born in Kansas City, Kansas on March 10th, 1937 and was 86 years old.

Bennita was a loving wife, mother, and grandmother. She enjoyed gardening and antiquing. She was a member of DAR (Daughters of the American Revolution) in Pulaski, UDC (United Daughters of the Confederacy) of Knoxville, TN and a member of the Pulaski Gardening Club. She was one of the first women to be hired by IBM where she worked for 20 years before taking an early retirement to go manage the computer lab for Clayton Homes for an additional 10 years. Bennita was the owner and operator of Lairdland Farm House. While owning the Historical Farm House, she worked with schools for 11 years to educate the youth on early living history.
