Benny Waddle, Jr of Pulaski passed away Monday, August 24, 2020 peacefully at his residence. He was born on April 25, 1924 in Madison, Alabama.

Elder Waddle was known as Buddy or little Benny Jr, Baby Brother, or Pastor. Elder Waddle professed hope in Christ in 1940 and joined St. Andrew P.B Church under the leadership of Elder W.M. Holden. Elder Waddle was called to preach the gospel in 1962 and was licensed in 1964 and was ordained in 1965. Elder Waddle was assistant Pastor at Bethlehem P.B. Church under the leadership of Elder Will Eddie Olds. Elder Waddle became the Pastor of Mt. Zion P.B. Church. In 1980 he became the pastor of St. Rebecca P.B. Church in Pulaski, TN for the first time. In 1984 he was joined in holy matrimony to Lois Ann Bridgeforth and moved to Pulaski, TN. In 1986 God saw fit to send him to Jerusalem P.B. Church to assist Elder Robert Holman until his passing following that he returned to St, Andrew P.B. Church as an associate Minister. In 2004 he was called back to St Rebecca P.B. Church in Pulaski, TN where he still remained as Pastor until God called him home.
