



## Charles Richard Brewer

November 25, 1928 - February 5, 2016

Charles Richard (Red) Brewer of Pulaski passed away on Friday, February 5, 2016. He was born in Caledonia, Mississippi on November 25, 1928 and was 87 years old.

He was a Deacon Emeritus, Trustee, and Character Builders Sunday School teacher for 30 years at First Baptist Church in Pulaski. He attended Lee High School in Columbus, Mississippi and Copiah Lincoln Junior College in Wesson, Mississippi. He graduated from the University of Memphis where he was a letterman in football and baseball. Charles is a member of the University Hall of Fame and Bill Wade Unsung Heroes All American Hall of Fame. He was a coach and teacher at Dyersburg High School, Principal at Beech Hill High School and Pulaski Junior High/Bridgeforth Middle schools. He was a United States Air Force Veteran in the Korean War serving in the Philippines.

Visitation will be on Saturday, February 6th from 2:00pm until 6:00pm at Bennett-May-Giles County Funeral Home.

Funeral Service will follow on Sunday, February 7th at 2:00pm at First Baptist Church with Tony Gomillion, Rodney Hawkins, and Leon Reed officiating.
