Several nieces and nephews also survive.

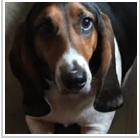

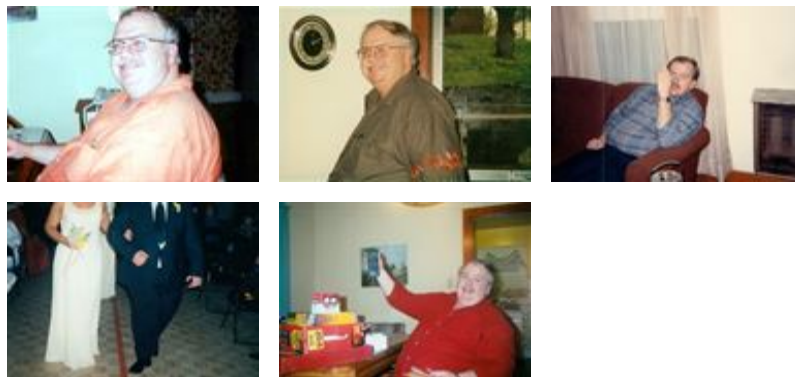
