She was a member of the Smokey Bears Ladies Auxiliary who assisted the local Rhinelander Fire Department with fundraising and support during emergencies. She was also a board member of the Crescent Lake Association in Rhinelander. She was a talented visual artist and upon moving to Pulaski, became part of the STAAR Theatre Family.
