Hubert Max White of Pulaski passed away Wednesday morning, November 6, 2019, at NHC of Pulaski. He was born in Minor Hill, Tennessee on April 20th, 1940 and was 79 years of age.

Max held an advanced degree in mathematics. He was a veteran of the Tennessee Army National Guard achieving the rank of Colonel. He was retired from the Pulaski Electric System. During his retirement he was a Boy Scout leader and was able to take the same group of 14 boys from Tiger Cub to Eagle Scout. Twice Max and his son, Bert, attended Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico. Max was also a member and elder of the First Presbyterian Church. Some things he enjoyed doing during his life were woodworking, snow skiing in the Rockies, and flying a personal plane. He adored his family and was a devoted father and husband.
