



James F. Cooper

February 6, 1931 - August 22, 2012

Dr. James Francis Cooper of Pulaski passed away August 22, 2012 at his residence in Pulaski.

He was born on February 6, 1931 in Owensboro, Kentucky and was 81 years old.

Dr. Cooper graduated from East Nashville High School in 1948, Vanderbilt University with a bachelors Degree in 1952, University of Tennessee in 1953, Columbia University with a Masters Degree in 1956, and Ph.D. from Union Institute in 1986.

His career spanned from 1956 until 1971 as Clinical Social Worker at Gailor Psychiatric Hospital and at the Memphis Mental Health Center as Chief Clinical Social Worker. From there his career took him to Harriett Cohn Guidance Center in Clarksville, Tennessee. He was the Director of the Maury County Mental Health Center and the Giles County Mental Health Center. He had a private practice in Individual Psychotherapy and marriage and family counseling in Pulaski and Nashville. He was also an Adjunct Professor at Martin Methodist College in Pulaski, TN.

His memberships include a Charter member of the National Association of Social Workers, Diplomata Clinical Social Work, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, NASW Register, Associate Member of the Society for Clinical and Experimental Hypnosis, Certified by the Tennessee Department of Mental Health to assess the Competency to Stand Trial Determinations, and was President of the Mediation Association of Tennessee, the Middle Tennessee

Chapter.

A memorial service to celebrate the life of Dr. Cooper will be 6 o'clock Sunday, August 26, 2012, in the Chapel of Bennett-May-Giles County Funeral Home. The family suggest memorial donations be made in his honor to the charity of your choice.

He was preceded in death by his parents John Russell and Frances Hope Clark Cooper along with his brother John Clark Cooper.
