He is preceded in death by his parents James Merlin McCormack, Sr. and Mary Frances McCormack.

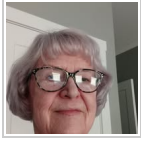

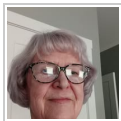
