Katherine W. "Kitty" Brewer of Pulaski passed away on Saturday, September 6, 2025, at NHC Pulaski. She was born in Dallas, Texas on May 18, 1931, and was 94 years old.

Kitty was a loving mother, grandmother, great grandmother and friend. She dedicated her career to education, retiring from the Giles County Board of Education. A woman of strong faith, she was a devoted member of First Baptist Church, where she faithfully served as church historian, participated in the Gleaners Sunday School class, and shared her musical talents as organist for over 30 years. She served as a member and past president of the Pulaski Garden Club. She was also a lifetime member of the Tennessee Federation of Garden Clubs and the Giles County Historical Society.
