He would serve at Willow Grove for 9 years and as Moderator of the Greater Richland Creek MB Association for a year. Rev. Duke began serving as the Pastor of Happy Hill MB Church in 2010 until his death.

Pastor Duke also enjoyed singing God's praises. He sung with the Gospel Harmonizers and formed two quartets: The Duke Family Gospel Singers and Rev. Kenneth Duke & The Family Ambassadors.

And, Pastor Duke enjoyed gatherings with his kids and grandkids. Pastor Duke was truly a man after God's own heart, who loved preaching, teaching and singing The Word of God.
