Nancy Elizabeth Brandon Rogers passed away at NHC - Sumner Place in Gallatin, TN on July 30, 2025. She was 95 years old. Mrs. Rogers was born in Leeville, TN in Wilson County on March 23, 1930.

Having grown up as a "preacher's kid", she lived in numerous hamlets and communities throughout Middle Tennessee including Leeville, Cross Plains, White Plains, Westmoreland, Saint Joseph, and Prospect. Known to most friends and family as Libby, she graduated from Cross Plains High School in 1947 where she played varsity basketball. Libby was a 1949 graduate of Martin Methodist College where she met and married Pulaski native and the love of her life, Edwin Rogers. She was a long-time resident of Pulaski, TN and a life-long member of the Methodist Church.

At the time of her death, Libby was a member at Saint Andrews Methodist Church in Pulaski. She was employed at Lemar Shirt Factory for many years and later retired from Pulaski Housing Authority. Libby was a talented seamstress and created countless hand-sewn, smocked and embroidered dresses for her four granddaughters who will continue to cherish these beautiful creations for generations to come.
