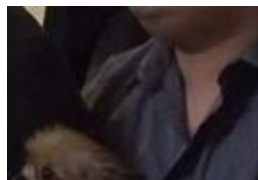

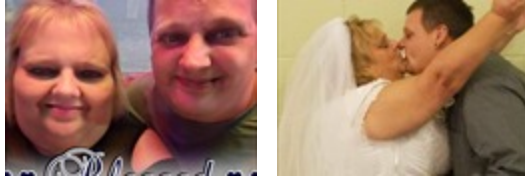

Stephen stood up quickly and his arm shot up in the air and he screamed out, "JESUS DID IT"!!!

I told the class, "Don't laugh, Stephen was right! Jesus makes all things better." Stephen could have been a good preacher. He was kind, generous, and helpful at all times.
