Terry Raymond Hickman passed away on Friday, September 6, 2024 at NHC Healthcare, Pulaski, Tennessee. He was born in Pulaski on August 2, 1942 and was 82 years old.

Terry was a lifelong resident of Pulaski and attended Giles County High School where he was a standout member of the GCHS Football Team. He had a hard work ethic and started Terry Hickman Distributing in 1972 and sold the business in 1996. During these years he sponsored and was active with several men's softball teams in Giles County. He was an avid fisherman and hunter and owned a World Champion Coon Dog name "Slim". He loved horses and had countless dogs over the years. He was always up for a good prank and had a wonderful sense of humor. He loved to make people laugh and to know him was to love him. For many years, Terry enjoyed entertaining during weekends at the river with family and friends, loved boating and grilled an amazing steak. He was loved dearly by his children, grandchildren, his dog Mickey, and his wife, Elaine, who was the absolute love of his life for 63 very short years.

After selling his business in 1996, Terry drove a school bus for children with disabilities for a number of years. He had a heart for children and was known for his countless acts of kindness to those less fortunate. Terry was a member of the Second Street Church of Christ.
