William R. Rackley of Carthage died on Wednesday, September 14, 2016 with family at his side.

Bill was born in Pulaski on June 6, 1934 to parents Joseph M. Rackley and Jane Zuccarello Rackley. He graduated from Giles County High School. He attended Vanderbilt University on a full Craig Scholarship and graduated cum laude with a degree in Civil Engineering.
