Mr. Woodrow Strawn age 89, of Pulaski passed away Friday, September 7, 2007 at NHC Healthcare in Pulaski. Mr. Strawn was born January 10, 1918 in Giles County where he graduated from Campbellsville High School in 1936. He joined the U.S. Navy, October 15, 1940. He completed basic training in Norfolk, Virginia, and served aboard the USS Hayter, a destroyer escort in the North Atlantic during World War II.

He married Mary Ellen Reed on December 23, 1942 and they had one son, Woodrow Wilson Strawn, Jr. He was elected Giles County Trustee 1948-1952. Mr. Strawn was a Mason and member of Pulaski Lodge No. 101 F&Am, a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, member of the Al Menah Temple, and a member of First Presbyterian Church, the American Legion and the VFW. He entered the insurance firm of Martin and Strawn, and later joined with lifelong friend, Tol Eslick to establish Eslick & Strawn Insurance.
